We create an environment where every child receives the attention they need, giving them the opportunity to study the school curriculum at their own pace. Our project helps youngsters to pass their exams and choose a profession that suits best. We also encourage children to find new hobbies and overcome any fears in communication with other people.

We bring together volunteers, activists, students, university teachers, foundations and organisations to set up classes for our students.

GENERAL BASIC EDUCATION BLOCK

This is the main area of work of School Friend

FOR STUDENTS

- Classes in subjects on the school curriculum
- Individual training programmes based on the student's level, timeframe and goals
- \swarrow Exam preparation for students in grades 4, 9, and 11
- Help in mastering needed subjects and improving overall academic performance
- Additional courses in Spanish, Chinese, Korean and Japanese are available

English, French, German, biology, geography, computer science, history, literature, mathematics, world art culture, fundamentals of health and safety, life sciences, social studies, Russian, physics, etc.

CAREER GUIDANCE AND PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSISTANCE BLOCK

Help adolescents decide on a career

FOR STUDENTS

- Career advice and assistance in finding an interesting and in-demand occupations
- Lectures and practical lessons with creative tasks on various professions
- Psychological support, help cope with conflicts and stress, both during exams and in everyday life

FOR PARENTS AND EDUCATORS

- Recommendations for different behaviours, advice and instructions on how to overcome and prevent "dangerous" situations
- Help in developing a rapport with teenagers

A pilot programme with a group of students with disabilities is on the plan line

PUBLIC SPEAKING AND CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT

A series of training seminars to help gain self-confidence:

- Developing the students' imagination
- Letting go of internal and external sources of stress
- Overcoming one's fear of public speaking
- Developing emotional intelligence
- Improving communication and interaction with peers and adults

GETTING STARTED

Individual and group (up to three people) consultations on the choice of the next educational institution (college, university):

- Determining the student's professional preferences
- Finding out the opportunities in the region where the undergraduate lives
- Personal development and career planning map
- Aid with preparing and submitting applications
- Information support at all stages

Expansion of the mental outlook and implementation of the sociocultural approach in education

SPORTS AND LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Morning get-togethers, parties, health days.

LANGUAGES OF THE WORLD

English, Spanish, Chinese, Korean, German, French, and Japanese from beginner's level.

GEOGRAPHY OF RUSSIA

Lectures and creative assignments to explore the nature, history and culture of Russia. Students will learn about the unique history of the regions, their attractiveness for tourists, the values of indigenous peoples and the development of the territories.

- Submit documents signed by the child's legal representative (confirmation of eligibility, consent to the processing of personal data, application for participation in the project)
 - Receive confirmation and make a preliminary class schedule

- children and adolescents from low-income families
- orphans and children without parental care
- children and adolescents with disabilities
