





THE UN75 SDGs CONTEST

In December, the **#FriendsforSDGs** competition was held for a dedicated grant from the UN-75 Office (USD\$ 1,000) jointly with the UN Information Center in Moscow, the Roscongress Foundation, and TV-BRICS to collect projects to implement the 17 Sustainable Development Goals until 2030

More than **500 projects from 93 countries** were received. Out of those, the best 100 were selected, coming from 61 countries. Work is underway with the best projects, and their founders have joined the FFL community


